



Hilton Rose Hall Resort & Spa

Overview

White-sand beach, golf

Just a 15-minute drive from Sangster Airport, this resort is cradled between its own championship golf course and private white-sand beach.

Balconies, terraces

The 488 guestrooms accented with dark tropical hardwoods and include ceramic tile floors feature private balconies or terraces; many have ocean views.

Water park, lazy river

The on-site water park features a 280 ft. slide, waterfalls, lagoons, and a lazy river.

What to Expect: Set between the Blue Mountains and the blue waters of the Caribbean Sea, the Rose Hall Resort & Country Club caters to couples and families. The resort occupies what was once an 18th century sugar plantation. Many guests enjoy walking to the historic Rose Hall Great House one km (half-mile) away, which was once the home of Annie Palmer, anointed the "White Witch of Rose Hall."

Amenity Highlights: The resort is popular with families seeking getaways for active children. A highlight for all ages is the water park, Sugar Mills Falls, which features three terraced pools, lagoons, waterfalls, a lazy river, a water slide, two secluded spa tubs, and a swim-up bar. Adjacent to the main building, a 36.5-meter (120-foot) freeform pool also contains a swim-up bar and a children's section connected by a channel. The beach runs 914 meters (1000 yards). Pool decks and the private beach feature cushioned lounge chairs, umbrellas, and cabanas.

Insider Tip: In addition to the resort's golf course (surcharges), guests can also play the Ironshore Golf Course located five km (three miles) away.

Room Features

Guests at the Rose Hall Resort & Spa may book either an All-Inclusive plan or a Room-Only plan.

Both plans include daytime tennis play; daily access to the fitness center; use of all non-motorized water sports, gear, and equipment; self parking; use of in-room safes; in-room coffee and tea service; pool/beach towels; cushioned poolside lounge chairs; and related taxes, fees, and charges.

In addition, All-Inclusive options include food, beverages, entertainment, and use of the waterpark.

The resort offers 488 guestrooms in two, seven-story wings. All rooms come with a patio or balcony to enjoy views of the water, golf course, or garden/mountains. Decor includes a neutral chic white palette accented with dark tropical hardwoods.

Features include pillowtop mattresses, premium linens, feather pillows, flat-panel TVs, two dual-line telephones with voice mail, wireless Internet access (surcharge), and in-room safes. Coffeemakers come with Jamaican Blue Mountain coffee and bathrooms offer Spa bath amenities. Refrigerators are provided in all guestrooms.

Ocean View These 370 square feet rooms offer accommodations perfectly in tune with Jamaica's natural rhythm and tone. The rooms feature a host of tropical touches - including pastel walls, wicker furniture, and hand-made tiling. Take advantage of breathtaking pool and ocean views, a sitting area, and a cozy studio atmosphere.

Mountain View These 370 square feet rooms offer a private balcony/terrace overlooking either the rolling fairways or majestic mountains with glimpses of the sparkling Caribbean sea. The Mountain View Rooms feature tropical decor that includes pastel walls, wicker furniture, and hand-made tiling. Property Amenities

Guests of the Rose Hall Resort & Spa, A Hilton Resort may book either an All-Inclusive plan or a room-Only plan. All-Inclusive plans include meals, drinks, and gratuities. Room-Only plans do NOT include meals, drinks, and gratuities. Both plans include the majority of resort-offered amenities and activities. (Scroll up to the All-Inclusive Plan Details section for more information.)

Agaming lounge contains slot, video-poker, and blackjack machines (surcharges for tokens). The Cricket Club disco offers early-evening entertainment such as karaoke, dance lessons, and bingo, followed by DJ music and dancing until well after midnight. An open-air theatre draws guests with live interactive music and dance shows. A fitness center contains cardio and weight machines as well as free weights. And a kids' club with adjacent sand playground offers supervised activities during the day for children age 4-12.

A health and beauty spa offers massage, body treatments, facials, waxing, and hair and nail care (surcharges for all treatments and services). A business center contains four computers with dial-up Internet access, fax machines, and a photocopy machine (surcharges for services). The resort offers more than 1021 square meters (11,000 square feet) of flexible meeting space and banquet facilities. Five shops adjoining the lobby sell gifts, sundries, jewelry, perfume, leather goods, and personal electronics. The lobby is also the site of a daily art show and a weekly craft market when local artisans bring in handmade straw items, coral jewelry, T-shirts, and handmade clothing. Shipping of purchases can be arranged.

Dining

Guests may book either an All-Inclusive plan or a Room-Only plan. All-Inclusive plans include meals, drinks, and gratuities, at the following restaurants, snack spots, and bars (some restrictions apply). Room-Only plans do NOT include meals, drinks, and gratuities.

Luna di Mare

Located at pool level. Intimate, air-conditioned dinner restaurant serving Italian cuisine. Antipasti bar. Reservations required. (Guests guaranteed one visit per stay.) Dress code: Casually elegant, with long pants, collared shirts, and closed-toe shoes for men. Closed one night a week.

The Terrace

Open-air pool-view restaurant serving American breakfast and dinner buffets. Nightly entertainment includes cabaret shows, steel bands, and limbo dancing.

Three Palms Restaurant

Adjacent to the golf course, with indoor and outdoor fine dining. International cuisine for 4-course dinner experience. Reservations required. (Guests guaranteed one visit per stay.) Dress code: Casually elegant, with long pants, collared shirts, and closed-toe shoes for men. Closed one night a week.

Java Café

Casual, air-conditioned spot with yellow-rattan chairs, pale-yellow walls, Jamaican art. Serving light meals for breakfast, lunch, dinner; pastries.

Mangoes Restaurant

Casual, open-air lunch spot at the water park, with swim-up bar. Open daily from mid-morning to mid-afternoon for finger food: burgers, hot dogs, and sandwiches. Bar open to early evening.

The Pool Grille & Bar

Poolside location and American fare such as sandwiches and salads. Open daily from mid-morning to mid-afternoon. Bar open until early evening for tropical drinks.

The Gazebo Bar

This open-air, ocean-view lobby bar provides seating under a peaked wood roof and on a terrace. Sports television and tropical drinks with bar snacks.

Pool Bar

Located in the main pool and courtyard area, this bar is part swim-up bar. Open from mid-morning to early evening.

Pool Grille

Close to the main pool, serves finger food from noon to mid-afternoon.

Cricket club

This disco opens in the evening with live music, DJs, sports TV, karaoke, sing-a-longs, games, and plenty of reggae. Drinks and bar snacks. Located on the lobby level next to the gaming lounge.

Recreation

Guests may book either an All-Inclusive plan or a Room-Only plan. Please note the following recreational amenities may not apply to all guests (scroll up to the All-Inclusive Plan Details section for more information).

A water park meanders through a jungle garden and contains three terraced swimming pools, channels, little lagoons, waterfalls, a lazy river with float tubes, and a swim-up bar. A rope-and-wood suspension bridge, faux rock formations, and replicas of the former Rose Hall Plantation's aqueducts (whose ruins can be found elsewhere within the resort) are also in the jungle garden. Among the replicas is a sugar mill 9 meters (30 feet) high, providing access to an 85-meter (280-foot) serpentine waterslide. Other features include two secluded six-person spa tubs, one with waterfall.

Adjacent to the main building, a freeform pool 36.5 meters (120 feet) long contains a swim-up bar and children's sections connected by a channel. The resort's beach extends 914 meters (1000 yards) and provides calm-water swimming in most weather conditions. Pool decks and the beach are set with cushioned lounge chairs, umbrellas, and cabanas.

Water sports equipment and activities include small sailboats, snorkeling gear, windsurfers, and kayaks plus Pilates and aerobics classes. The resort also features six tennis courts (surcharges for night games). Play on the resort's 18-hole championship golf course, Cinnamon Hill Ocean Course, incurs a surcharge. The course, which has played host to the Caribbean Classic Golf Championship, traverses tropical greenery, offers mountain and ocean vistas, and rises from sea level to an elevation of 374 meters (900 feet). Caddies and carts are mandatory. Rental carts, clubs, and other equipment as well as golf lessons are offered at a pro shop. (Soft spikes are recommended.)

Off-site activities including scuba diving certification classes and trips; snorkeling and glass-bottom boat excursions; plus horse riding, parasailing, waterskiing, and Jet Skiing can all be arranged at the resort. Off-site activities incur surcharges.
