What to Expect: Originally a private estate, this resort owes its existence to Huntington Hartford II, the legendary 1950s playboy who bought the estate and converted it into a resort for his jet-set crowd. Its glittering 1962 opening drew entertainment luminaries, royalty, and politicians from around the world. Current owners bought the resort in 1994 and spent \$100 million renovating and expanding. Celebrities and world travelers still come, only now they seek seclusion rather than attention. Utter tranquility and hushed, discreet service on 35 garden acres awaits them.

Amenity Highlights: Running for three miles along Paradise Island's north shore and accessible by a wood staircase, an uncrowded beach of fine white sand borders the turquoise Atlantic Ocean. Neat rows of cushioned lounge chairs fitted with folding shades furnish sunbathing comfort. Evian-water misting and afternoon sorbet offer heat relief. In the resort's renowned Versailles-styled gardens is a large pool surrounded by palm trees and cushioned wrought-iron lounge chairs. Loungers enjoy full views of the gardens, which feature a 12th century Augustinian cloister.

Insider Tip: Complimentary shuttles transport guests 0.5 miles west on Paradise Island to the Atlantis resort (a partner property), where they enjoy access to all facilities and charging privileges, including 21 restaurants and lounges. Atlantis features 11 million gallons of water attractions, including a saltwater swimming, watersports, and snorkeling lagoon; numerous waterslides and pools; and 11 marine-life viewing lagoons. Also available are a teen club, the children's educational Discovery Channel Camp, and a 50,000-square-foot casino.

Beachfront Suite The luxury Beachfront suites are 1100 sq. ft. one bedroom suites with a separate parlor in contemporary, elegant island decor. It features a full size, spacious patio or balcony with ceiling fan, table and chairs and chaise lounges. The bedroom features a king bed, ceiling fan, in-room safe, iron and ironing board, armoire, walk-in closet, clock radio, two direct dial telephones with voice mail, 32 color satellite TV, DVD player, CD player, individual climate control, and internet access. The bathroom features double sinks, walk-in shower, large tub with jets, robe, scale, hair dryer, enclosed toilet and bidet, magnifying mirror, marble countertops, and a telephone.

Garden View Suite Washed in soft colors and textures inspired by this paradise, each expansive one-bedroom suite offers a King-size bed. A separate parlor features elegant furnishings and modern amenities for dining and entertaining. Sliding glass doors lead to an adjoining terrace or balcony with sweeping views of the Atlantic or gardens. Bathrooms are adorned in marble with Roman bath, separate showers, and twin sink basins.

Beachfront The luxury Beachfront room is a 550 sq. ft. guest room in contemporary, elegant island decor. It features a full size, spacious patio or balcony with ceiling fan, table and chairs and chaise lounges. The room features a king bed, ceiling fan, mini-bar, in-room safe, iron and ironing board, armoire, chest, one large closet, sitting area with table and chairs, armchair, lounge chair, clock radio, direct dial telephone with voice mail, 32 color satellite TV, DVD player, CD player, individual climate control, and internet access. The bathroom features two vanities, each with a sink, robe, scale, hair dryer, enclosed toilet, magnifying mirror, enclosed shower, large tub, and telephone.

Ocean View Satellite TV with DVD and CD players, DMX satellite radio channels, Complimentary laptops available on request, Complimentary high-speed Internet access, State-of-the-art voice and data lines, Luxurious bathroom with large tub, Private bar, Pillow menu.

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Garden View Located in the Hartford Wing which offers lovely views of the garden grounds. The room opens to a patio or balcony and is perfect for relaxing.

2 Bedroom Garden Cottage Secluded with the garden grounds is a cluster of four cottages. Each 860ft, two-bedroom, two-bath hideaway offers King-size or Euro-king beds. French doors connect a spacious parlor and dining area to a large enclosed courtyard, ideal for private sunning or outdoor dining.

Hotel Details

Property Amenities

Featuring eight private treatment villas suitable for couples as well as singles, the resort's health spa employs Asian holistic rituals and includes a beauty salon offering private rooms with hardwood floors and gilt-frame mirrors. Decorated with Balinese carved-wood accents and Thai silk pillows, each villa includes side-by-side Javanese-teak treatment tables and a two-person shower with oversized rainfall showerhead. Outside, a private garden-courtyard contains a two-person Balinese daybed under a wood-shingle roof, as well as a two-person jetted tub. Signature offerings include the Ocean Club massage (two therapists employing five massage techniques), Elemis Aroma Spa Ocean Wraps (heated seaweed body masks followed by massage), and Elemis Fennel Cleansing Cellulite and Colon Therapy (detoxifying body mask and massage). Stretching from this resort to near Nassau Harbor, the 0.25-mile-long gardens (built by Huntington Hartford II and modeled after the French original in Versailles) consist of seven terraces graced by Carrera-marble and bronze statues, including two of Empress Josephine reclining at the gardens' entrance; a 12th century Greek statue of Hercules; and two giant bronze statues of Hartford heroes Franklin D. Roosevelt and explorer David Livingston. The gardens' apex features a 12th century Augustinian cloister from France that Hartford purchased from William Randolph Hearst. Located on the lip of a low bluff between sloping lawns and the beach, a weathered-wood deck pierced by a single palm tree supplies a panoramic ocean view for twice-daily yoga classes. Snuggled again a seagrape hedge nearby, a tent-cabana offers the same view for open-air massage. Hammocks stretch between palm trees throughout the resort's 35 acres.

Ground transportation: Shuttle vans or private cars of varying prices are available. They can be selected during the process of booking a reservation for this hotel, via this Web site, and added to the total trip cost.

Dune

Beachfront, 90-seat restaurant designed by famed French interior designer Christian Liaigre and created by renowned chef/restaurateur Jean-Georges Vongerichten. Minimalist décor. Best of Jean-Georges" dinner menu with Bahamian accents such as peekytoe crab fitters, foie gras brulée, snapper with carrot confit, seven-spice rack of lamb. Lunch choices such as chili lobster sandwich, wasabi-tuna pizza and conch salad. Breakfast selections such as smoked salmon with potato pancake, crisp semolina cakes with roasted pineapple and Gruyere omelet.

Dune Bar

Adjacent to Dune restaurant. Open-air seating in white wood pavilion and on deck overlooking beach. Marble bar lighted after dark. Lunch menu from Dune.

Clubhouse

Overlooks the 9th and 18th holes of the Ocean Club Golf Course as well as the ocean. Indoor or outdoor dining on the scenic patio. Full bar. Open daily for breakfast and light lunches; dinner available on the weekends.

Pool Terrace Café

Open-air, covered seating under ceiling fans. Marble bar. Lunch of soups, salads, sandwiches and light meals such as seared ahi, Caribbean bento box of fish, shrimp, ceviche, grilled plantains and fruits.

Library Bar

Located in the One & Only Ocean Club's stately reception hall with panoramic ocean views. Warm and elegant atmosphere. Serving Cuban cigars, fine bradies, cocktails, wine and afternoon tea.

Courtyard Terrace

Experience contemporary Mediterranean cuisine and dine beneath the stars. The historic Courtyard Terrace is considered one of the most elegant settings on Paradise Island, where guests dine around a candle-lit fountain pool.
